WHEN does MAPSCorps happen?

- The program begins with orientation on Monday, June 23, and runs until Thursday, July 31
- Students work Monday Thursday, 9:00am 2:00pm, and are paid \$8.25/hour
- Every Friday from 9:00am 12:00pm there will be a voluntary enrichment program

HOW can I apply for MAPSCorps?

- Fill in the application with your personal information
 - For applicants who have just graduated high school: check that you are in high school, not college (even if you plan to attend college in the fall)
 - You must indicate which CPS you attended, or indicate that you have a Social Security number
